Fee can be paid by credit card, in cash, or by check made out to NMH, written on U.S. banks and in U.S. dollars.

**If you are applying for the Middle School Program**, list one first-period and one second-period major course (see course descriptions), plus an alternate choice. List your sport choice and three choices for minor courses in order of preference.

**If you are applying for College Prep**, list one major course, plus an alternate choice. List three choices for minor courses and three choices for sports in order of preference.

**If you are applying for English as a Second Language**, check the appropriate box on the Application for Admission. (Do not list major course choices.) ESL students entering grades 7–9 make minor course and sport choices from Middle School Program offerings; those entering grades 10–12 choose from College Prep offerings. ## APPLICATION AND FINANCIAL AID DEADLINES

### Students not applying for financial aid:

There is no application deadline. However, students are encouraged to apply early since some courses fill quickly. As soon as a student's file is complete, it is reviewed by our admission committee and the student is notified of the decision.

### Students applying for financial aid:

Families wishing to apply for financial aid must submit all application materials (including the Application for Admission, teacher recommendations, and school transcript) and financial aid materials (including the Application for Financial Aid and all supporting documentation). All materials must arrive at our office no later than March 1. Because requests for financial aid typically exceed our resources, financial aid applications that do not include all required documentation will not be considered.

Financial aid applicants' files will be reviewed after the March 1 deadline, and admission/financial aid decisions are mailed by March 15.
