Application Instructions

Follow all instructions carefully. No application for admission will be considered until all materials have been received.

1. **Fill out Application for Admission (Form A) completely and attach the required, nonrefundable application fee:**

\$50—US home address

\$100—non-US home address

All admission and enrollment materials are sent to international students by express mail. If a student is currently attending boarding school, copies of all materials are sent to the student at his/her school and to the parents at home.

If you are applying for the Middle School Program, list one first-period and one second-period major course (see course descriptions) plus an alternate choice, as their titles appear in the catalog. List your three choices for minor courses and your sports choices—in order of preference.

If you are applying for College Prep, list one major course choice, as the title appears in the catalog, plus an alternate choice. List your three choices for minor courses and for sports—in order of preference.

If you are applying for English as a Second Language, check the box on the Application for Admission. (Do not list major course choices.) ESL students entering grades 7–9 make minor course and sport choices from Middle School Program offerings; those entering grades 10–12 choose from College Prep offerings. List your three choices for minor courses and for sports—in order of preference.

If you are applying for Contemporary Dance Program, check the box on the Application for Admission. (Do not list major course, minor course, or sport choices.) Only Form A, the application fee, Form C, and your latest report card or transcript are required.

If you attended an NMH Summer Session program previously, only Form A, the application fee, and your latest report card or transcript are required, unless applying for financial aid. If you are applying for financial aid, you must also submit the two teacher recommendation forms.



If you also are applying to Northfield Mount Hermon School for the academic year and have already submitted teacher recommendations and transcripts, only NMH Summer Session Form A and the application fee are required. Check the appropriate box on page 2 of Form A, and we will get copies of your recommendations and transcripts from NMH's school-year admission office.

2. **Form B:** Print your name at the top of the form and give it, with an envelope provided by you, to your current English teacher. Ask that the form be placed in the envelope, which should be sealed and signed across the seal before being returned to you. (This form is not required for students applying for the Contemporary Dance Program.)

- Form C:** Print your name at the top of the form and give it, with an envelope provided by you, to another current teacher. Ask that the form be placed in the envelope, which should be sealed and signed across the seal before being returned to you.
 - Report Card/Transcript:** Send us a copy of your latest report card or transcript, including your most recent grades (if semester grades are not available, midterm grades may be sent). International students: Because methods of evaluation vary throughout the world, a translation of your school's grading system must be included with your transcript.

Application and Financial Aid Deadlines

Students not applying for financial aid:

There is no application deadline; however, students are encouraged to apply early since some courses fill quickly. As soon as a student's file is complete, it is reviewed by our admission committee, and the student is notified of the decision.

Students applying for financial aid:

Families wishing to apply for financial aid must submit all application materials (including the Application for Admission, teacher recommendations, and school transcript) and financial aid materials (including the Application for Financial Aid, copies of IRS 1040 forms, and all supporting documentation). All materials must arrive at our office no later than March 1, 2010. Because requests for financial aid typically exceed our resources, financial aid applications that do not include all required documentation will not be considered.

Each financial aid applicant's file is reviewed after the March 1 deadline, and financial aid decisions are mailed by March 15.
