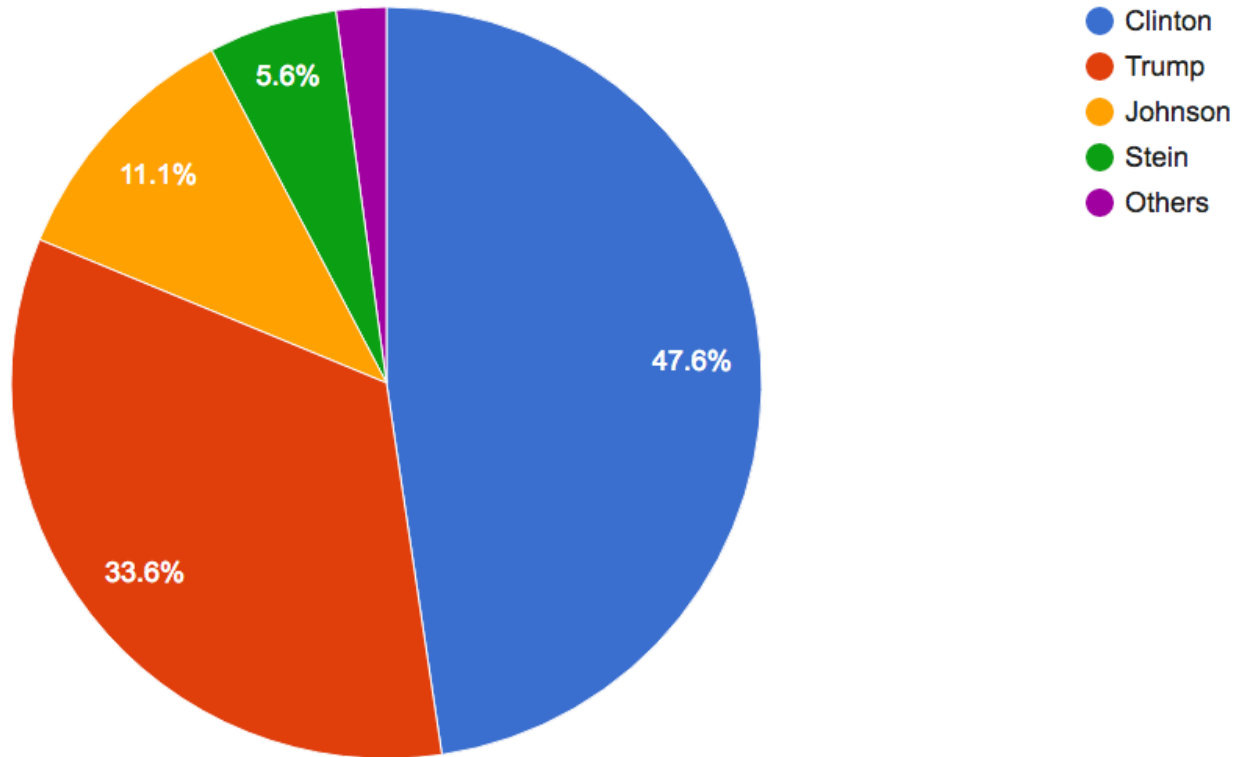

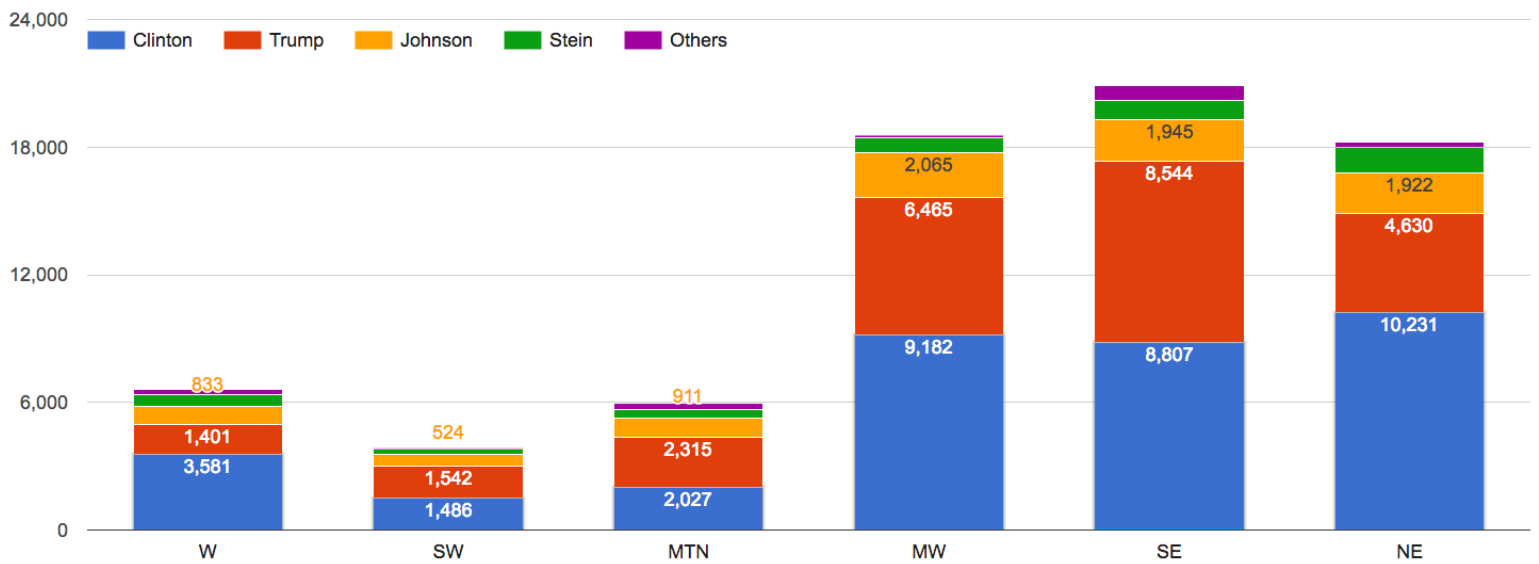
Interesting Notes:
